#### Safeguarding God's Children: Preventing Child Sexual Abuse

This training provides the tools to keep children safe. Participants will learn behavioral, emotional and physical boundary violations that perpetrators of abuse use to groom children. Discussion also includes warning signs in children/youth that abuse may be occurring and how to respond to prevent abuse from occurring and stop it. Since 2005, all of Sheridan's staff, council and volunteers who work with youth and children have participated in Safeguarding God's Children training. *This training is required for any adults helping with VBS or*

*going on a summer mission trip and must be renewed every three years.*


